Dear Sir,

I acknowledge receipt of your fax of 17 February 2004 requesting the European Court of Human Rights under Rule 39 of the Rules of Court to indicate to the Government of the Netherlands to provide the applicant with food and shelter.

Your application has been given the above file-number, to which you must refer in any further correspondence relating to this case.

On 18 February 2004, after examining the request, the President of the Chamber to which the case has been allocated decided not to indicate to the Government of the Netherlands, under Rule 39 of the Rules of Court, the interim measure you are seeking. However, notice of the introduction of this application has been given to the respondent Government in accordance with Rule 40 of the Rules of Court.

The President further decided that information was required from the respondent Government concerning provisions made for the applicant's subsistence pending the proceedings before the Court on his application no. 6276/03. The President has accordingly instructed me, under Rule 54 § 2 (a) of the Rules of Court, to request the Government to inform me what provision is made for the applicant's subsistence, including accommodation, following the withdrawal of state benefits and charitable help.


The Government have been asked to submit this information by 12 March 2004.

The information obtained from the Government will be sent to you in order that you may submit written comments in reply on behalf of the applicant.

You should fill in the enclosed application form carefully, legibly and completely as it will provide the basis for the Court's examination. It should be accompanied by **copies of all relevant documents**, in particular any decisions of national courts or authorities which you wish to challenge before the Court. The documents in question should be such as will enable the Court to verify that all domestic remedies have been exhausted as required by Article 35 § 1 of the Convention. **Please do not send originals as they will not be returned to you by the Court.** Failure to provide the necessary information will result in the application being rejected by the Court without further notice to you.
